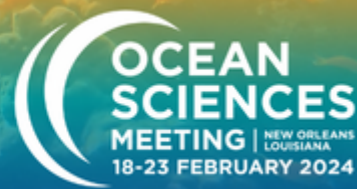

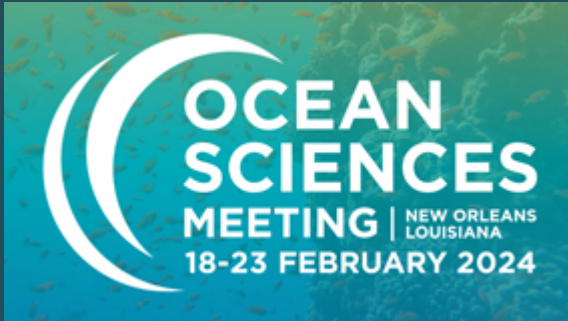


Congratulations to Kevin Reed!

New York City Mayor Eric Adams and The Trust for Governors Island announced that Stony Brook University will serve as the anchor institution for the development of a world-leading climate solutions center on Governors Island in the city's harbor. "The New York Climate Exchange" ("The Exchange") will be a first-of-its kind international center for developing and deploying dynamic solutions to our global climate crisis, while also acting as a hub for New Yorkers to benefit from the rapidly evolving green

economy.
